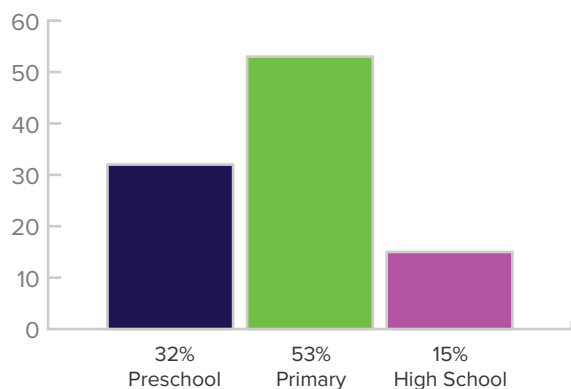




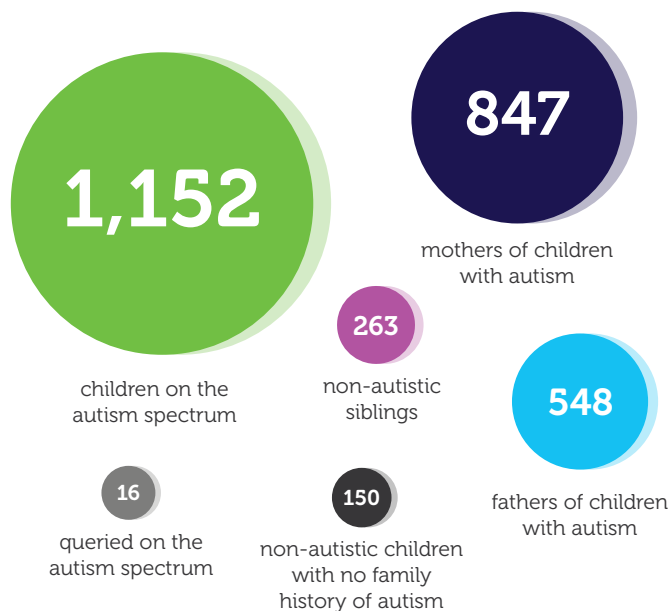
## Age Groups

The majority of participants are primary school aged.



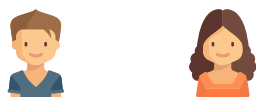
## Participants

Siblings



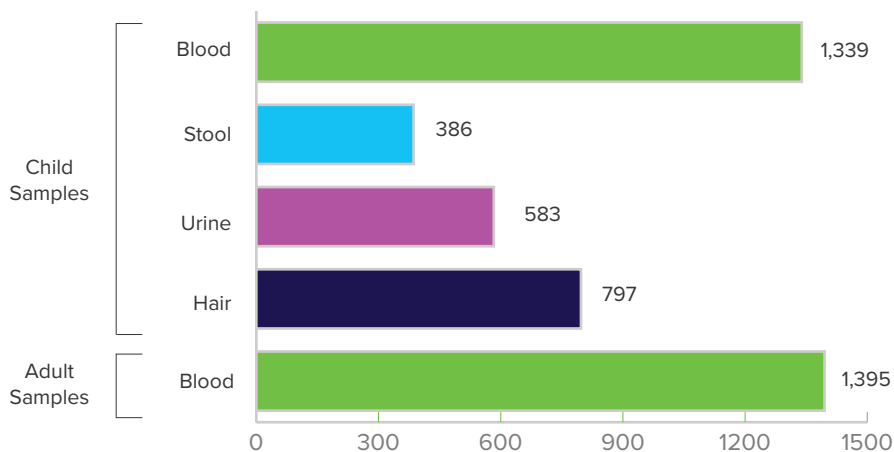

We also collected blood samples from parent participants.



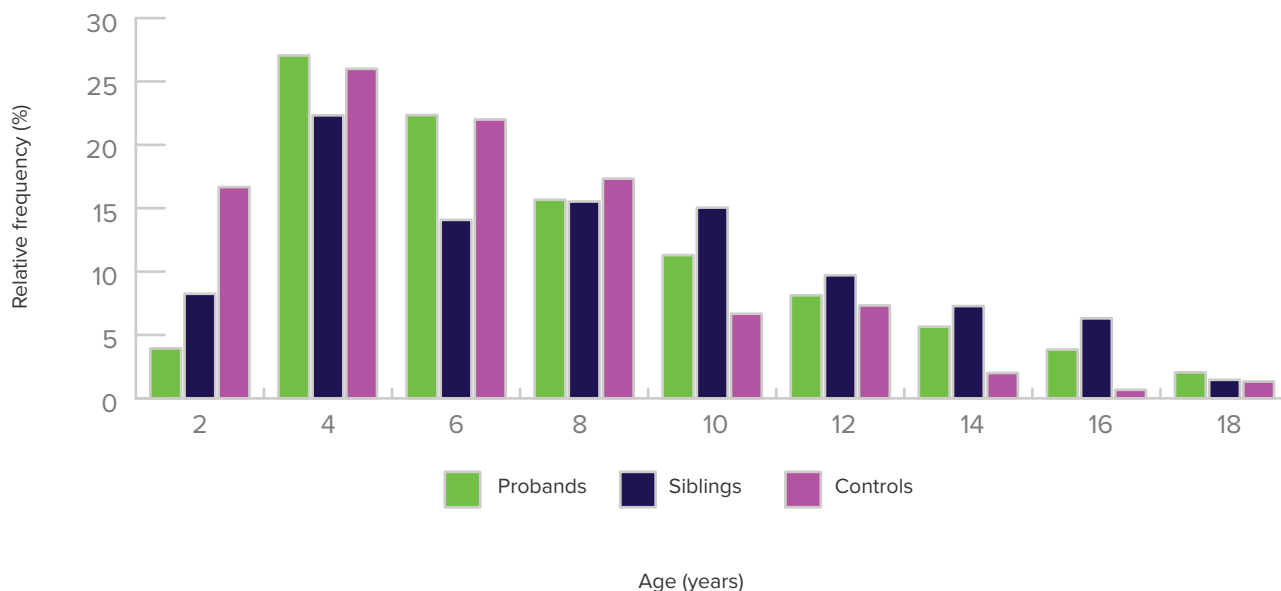
### Autism CRC Biobank

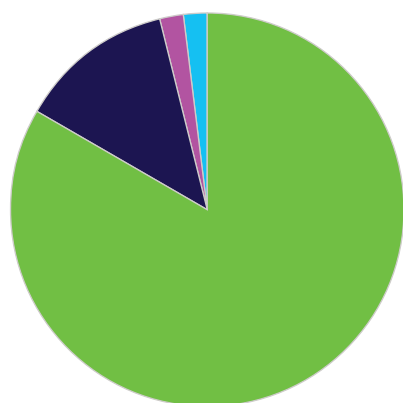
## Age Groups - Histogram
