Autism CRC's Sylvia Roger Academy runs programs by and for autistic adults in Australia and Aotearoa New Zealand.

They are going to run a program this year called the **Governance Program**.



Governance means how an organisation is managed.

The Program is for people who want to take a role on a board or other governance body, such as an advisory council, and want to learn more about how to do a good job.



A **board** is a group of people who make decisions about how to manage an organisation or company.

The Governance Program will teach people about:



- what people on boards do



- what the law says about being a board member



- how to plan for the future for an organisation



- making choices with how an organisation's money is used



- how to be a good board member.



You will get to meet other autistic people in the Program. You will also get to learn from people who are on boards.



You will need to apply for the Program by **26 April 2024**.
